ABOUT IMMIGRATION EQUALITY

Immigration Equality is the leading LGBTQ immigrant rights organization in the country. Each year, we provide advice and legal services to thousands of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and HIV-positive immigrants seeking refuge, fair treatment, and freedom in the United States.



OUR WORK

DIRECT LEGAL SERVICES

Immigration Equality provides free legal services to LGBTQ and HIV-positive asylum seekers. In the last 12 months, we have served 800 individuals from about 80 countries. Since we started our asylum program, our in-house attorneys and large pro-bono network have won asylum for over 1,500 individuals. Despite the incredible challenges the past few years have brought, we have maintained a 99% success rate.

LITIGATION

Through our impact litigation, we seek to change discriminatory policies affecting LGBTQ and HIV-positive people. In these cases, we may only represent a small group of people, but our aim is to get rulings that are far-reaching and improves the lives of our community on a large scale.

ADVOCACY

We have many long-term policy goals, many of which require comprehensive immigration reform. In the meantime, we are aware of several problems facing our community that President Joe Biden could solve immediately. We will continuously work to ensure all our priorities and heard, and hopefully addressed, throughout his term. In 2021, we won a case that led to the U.S. State Department eliminating a longstanding policy of refusing to acknowledge the U.S. citizenship of the children of many married same-sex couples.





Simone Mize-Gregg and Kessem Kiviti are two baby girls who were unjustly denied U.S. citizenship because they had two dads.

We sued the State Department last year, and have won multiple court cases on their behalf. However, the government kept appealing the courts' decisions, refusing to treat these families equally. That is, until October 2020. The government decided not to appeal one case and withdrew their previous appeal of the other. At long last, these families have the justice they deserved!



My name is Tarek and I am a gay man from Egypt. It is a crime to be gay there. As a young man, I was arrested, persecuted, and humiliated by the police for kissing another man. After my arrest, I was unable to find a job, and I lost many of my friends.

I felt like my life was ruined. I eventually started a relationship with a man in the United States. I came here to visit him, and it was then that I found out about Immigration Equality. They provided me free legal services, helped me win asylum and start a new life that I love.

Today, I live in Brooklyn and work as an architect and costume designer. One day, I will become a famous costume designer, and I dream of dressing Britney Spears and Lady Gaga. I designed a custom headdress for Miss Universe Iraq.
